## **Disabling the Pop-up Blocker**

By default, Internet Explorer and Firefox are configured to block pop-up windows. However, some websites make heavy use of popups for legitimate reasons.

### **Internet Explorer**

- 1. Open the Tools menu in the Command Bar.
- 2. Under "Pop-up Blocker", click "Turn off Pop-up Blocker".



# Firefox

1. Click the main menu button in the top-right and select Options.



2. Select the "Privacy and Security" category on the left.

- 2. Click the icon, select the "Always allow pop-ups..." option, and click Done.
