An independent reading club for ages birth to 12. Children select and read or listen to books, keep track of how long they read each day, and log their time online. Logging can be done off site or in the library. Check in at the library once a week to receive a reward, place your name on our display board, and receive a raffle slip for each 120 minutes (2 hours) of reading. End of Summer Reading and Grand Prize Party is Saturday, August 15, at 2 p.m.

Summer Reading How To

- ❖ Visit the library to get a Summer Reading packet on or after June 6.
- ❖ Go to www.mc-npl.org and look for the Be Creative @ Your Library Summer Reading Club link.
- ❖ Register for the program the first time you visit the site.
- ❖ Reach time you read, log in the number of minutes read.
- ❖ You are eligible to place your name on our display board and receive a raffle slip for our prize drawings for each 120 minutes (2 hours) of reading logged.
- ❖ Begin reading on or after June 6.
- ❖ Read aloud to a younger child and count the minutes.
- ❖ Listen to a book--audio books count, too.
- ❖ If you can't get to the library, visit a bookmobile.
- ❖ Attending selected programs will earn additional drawing slips.
