APRIL is FAMILY READING MONTH

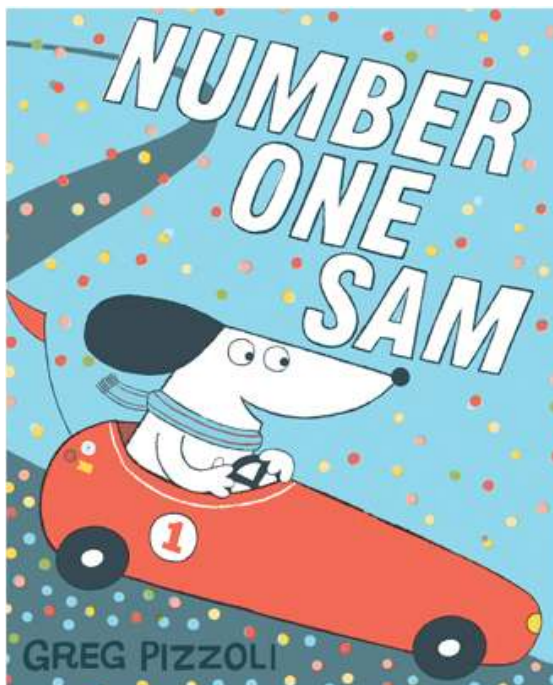
