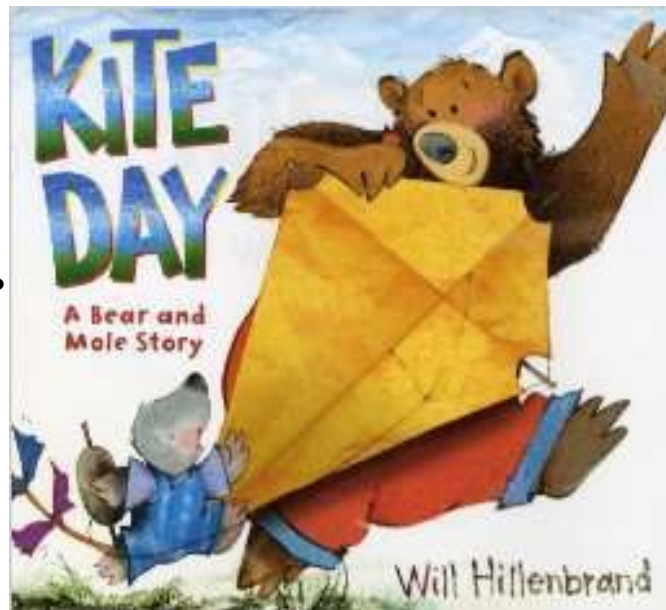
APRIL is FAMILY READING MONTH

campaign every spring, and Royersford Free Public Library is celebrating all April long!

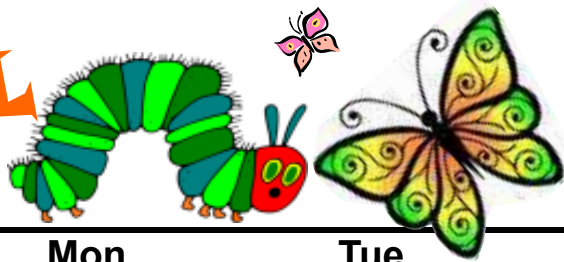

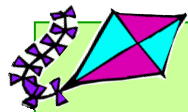

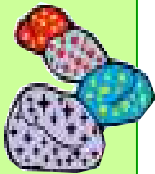
