

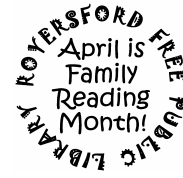

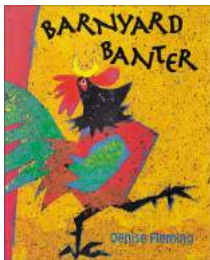


**APRIL is FAMILY READING at the Royersford Library!**  
**Your family is invited to join our fun!**

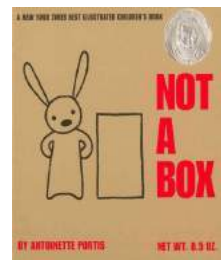
- Families set a goal of reading together for 20 minutes each day.

- Prizes valued at \$25 each. Winners will be called, and need not be present.

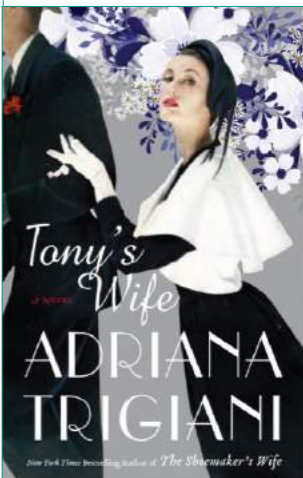
