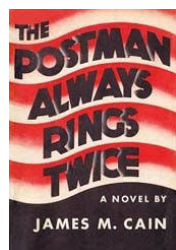
### Knit Knights

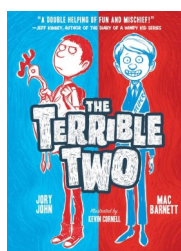
### Conshohocken Free Library Book Club
