

In order to prevent data loss, it is important to follow certain safety measures before removing a device.



First, and MOST important, *close* all open windows. *Check* your **taskbar** for "lit up" buttons very carefully.

Find the Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media icon in the Notification Area on the taskbar with the help of your screen tips. There may be another icon with a green check mark that looks similar, but it will have a different screen tip. Don't use that one!





Once you have found the correct icon, *click* on it. When you do, a menu will appear momentarily. *Click* on **Eject Data Traveler 2.0**.





Wait for a few seconds. If a notification appears at the bottom of the screen saying it's safe to remove the flash drive (pictured below), you may *remove* the drive from the computer.



If a warning dialogue appears instead (pictured below), it means that the flash drive is still in use. Make sure that **all** folders and files are indeed closed and then go back to **step 2**. This is **very important** to protect against data loss.
