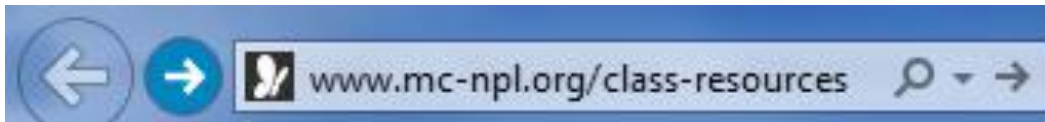



- 1.** Look for one of these icons on the desktop and **double-click** on it to open a web browser. If you can't find one, search for one in the Start Menu.
