Table Cursors

The diagram illustrates six different ways to interact with a table using the mouse cursor:

- Select a cell:** The cursor points to a specific cell (e.g., '3231').

- Select a row:** The cursor points to a row header (e.g., '3231').
- Move/select table:** The cursor points to the top-left corner of the table.
- Resize column width:** The cursor points to the vertical line between columns.
- Resize row height:** The cursor points to the horizontal line between rows.
